Shared Space – Pavilion Toilet	Players, Umpires	Spread of Virus	Medium	<p>All other Toilets at the Pavilion will be locked and the one remaining toilet, located in the main Pavilion room will be for the use of Players and Match Officials ONLY.</p> <p>Application of social distancing for use of Toilet. Everyone should maintain a distance of 2m where possible between themselves and other individuals if waiting for Toilet where they are asked to wait and respect others and prevent passing closer than 2metres.</p> <p>Toilet to be cleaned hourly by Home Team representative using anti-bacterial spray and paper towel which will, immediately after use, be placed in the Toilet bin for disposal at the end of the match by a designated Home team representative using gloves and a black bin liner.</p> <p>Soap and water will be available for toilet users and additional Sanitiser will be installed outside toilets by BCC.</p>	Both Teams and Match Officials to note and assist with. One Score book and Scorer may be the preferred solution with a local Score board by the one scorer table to be updated , say every 2 Overs by agreement. Scorebook, pencils/ pens to be regularly sanitised and, if a score board is used, this too will be regularly sanitised and used by one dedicated person only	Both Team Captains and Scorer	Low
