- 4. REPORT BY CHAIRMAN:**

The help of our sponsors, and in particular Meachers, who had helped up to re-roof the Pavillion L.Lawler for his perseverance in getting new sponsorship from Haydon Tyres and Freeborn Citroen, this money had been directed at the Colts, purchasing new shirts and training equipment.

The running of the Club takes a lot of time and effort and many thanks must go to our Secretary, Treasurer and Fixture Secretary, as well as other members of the Committee.

The Club website had been developed by A Hart and it was our aim to use it as a means of communication with members. It does not come free, but we will try it during the next year.

The next season will not be easy and will be a challenge both on and off the field, but let's look forward and make 2009 a season to remember.
